<u>Marriage</u>s: Reserve and register date & time as soon as possible, at least six months in advance of the wedding. Pre-Cana and other instructional sessions are required for all couples.

Sponsor letters: Church law requires sponsors to be active, registered Catholics and live according to Church teaching





If you are interested in singing with us, please contact Daniel Golden before Lent so you can attend mandatory rehearsals to prepare for Easter.






