




Life Lines

On 09/10/23, Pope Francis beatified the Ulma family, a Polish Catholic family of nine who were executed by the Nazis for hiding Jewish people. Jozef and Wiktoria Ulma, and their seven children, were declared martyrs in December, 2022. The Ulma family are not only the first family to be beatified together, but their youngest child is the first unborn baby to be directly honored in this way. Catholic News Agency reported that a bible was found in their home in which the Parable of the Good Samaritan had been highlighted in red ink. The Ulma family's feast day will be celebrated on July 7th, the date of the parents' wedding anniversary. (Catholicvote.org, September 2023)
