

<u>Baptisms:</u> Please call the rectory to arrange the celebration of Baptism. Baptisms ordinarily should not take place during Lent except in case of emergency. (Feb. 14th - March 30th, 2024)

<u>Marriages</u>: Reserve and register date & time as soon as possible, at least six months in advance of the wedding. Pre-Cana and other instructional sessions are required for all couples.

Sponsor letters: Church law requires sponsors to be active, registered Catholics and live according to Church teaching
