Confessions: Monday to Friday at 7:45am; Saturday from 3 to 3:30pm & After First Saturday Mass

Baptisms: Please call the rectory to arrange the celebration of Baptism. (Baptisms ordinarily should not take place during Lent except in case of emergency.)

Marriages: Reserve and register date & time as soon as possible, at least six months in advance of the wedding. Pre-Cana and other instructional sessions are required for all couples.

Ministry to the Sick: Please call the Rectory.

NOTE: Sponsor letters: Church law requires sponsors to be active, registered Catholics and live according to Church teachings.

Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA): Are you interested in becoming a Catholic? Please call the Rectory.

Parish Registration: All are welcome to join the Parish. If you are 18 years old and out of school, you are required to register separately from your family. You can call the rectory or visit stjosaphat-queens.org

All are asked to organize, vacuum & clean their closet before September.

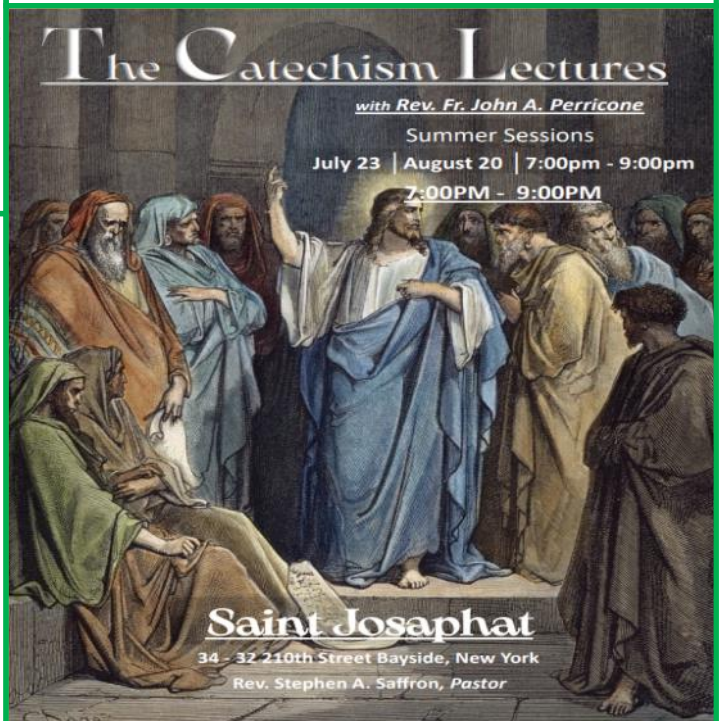
Any supplies left out will be disposed of.

The sisters have started an orphanage to take care of such condemned children, providing a home and education for them.

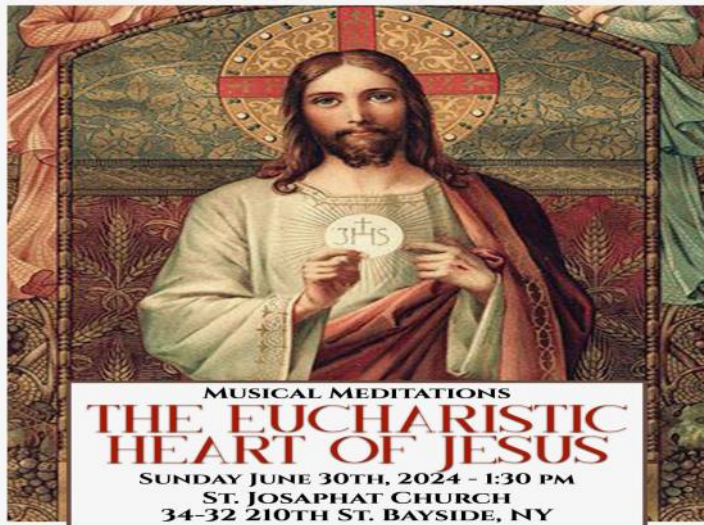
