Confessions: Monday to Friday at 7:45am; Saturday from 3 to 3:30pm & After First Saturday Mass

Baptisms: Please call the rectory to arrange the celebration of Baptism. (Baptisms ordinarily should not take place during Lent except in case of emergency.)

Marriages: Reserve and register date & time as soon as possible, at least six months in advance of the wedding. Pre-Cana and other instructional sessions are required for all couples.

Ministry to the Sick: Please call the Rectory.

NOTE: Sponsor letters: Church law requires sponsors to be active, registered Catholics and live according to Church teachings.

Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA): Are you interested in becoming a Catholic? Please call the Rectory.

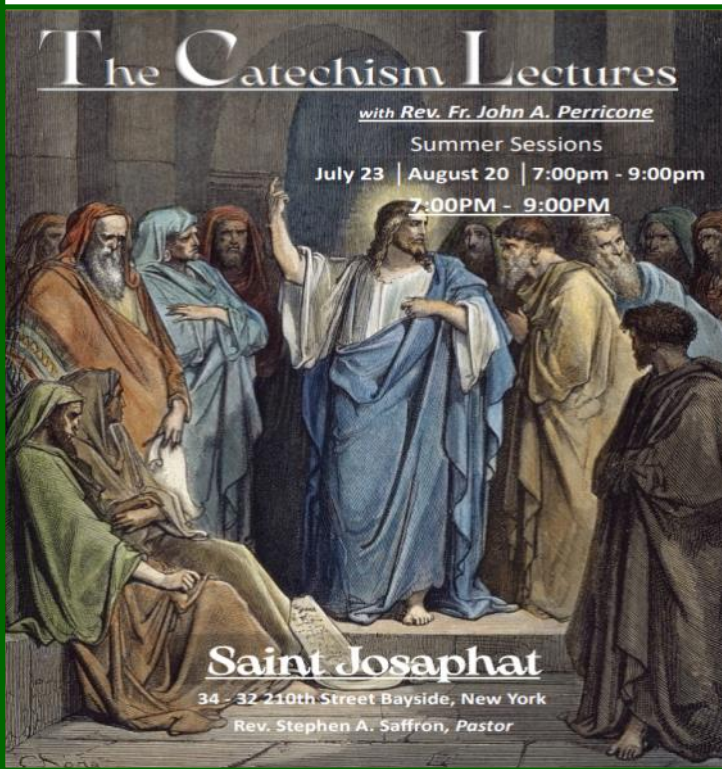

From the Desk of Fr. Saffron:

Confessions outside of scheduled times?

Confessions are :7:45 am on M, T, W, F.

3:00pm on Saturday

6:00pm on First Fridays (October-June)

7:45am First Saturdays

Asking for Confession in between Masses on Sunday is difficult since I regularly celebrate the 8am and 9.30 am Masses. The timing in-between is tight and don't justify your wanting Confession as "Father, got time for a quick Confession?" Your Confession will take/must take as long as is needed.

Scheduling of a private Confession is difficult since I'm the only priest here. Especially if you are asking for after office hours. In today's age, I must use discretion when alone outside of office hours.

So, I kindly ask that you follow the parish schedule for this Sacrament.

It is interesting to note that in the "old days," Confession was only on Saturday afternoon in most parishes, and the lines were long. Nowadays, with other options, many times, a priest sits alone.

The Hearths of the Holy Family

Consecration of every parish Family and home to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, the Immaculate Heart of Mary and the Chaste Heart of St. Joseph.

Every Parish Family is encouraged to purchase an image of the Holy Hearts.

During the First Fridays and Saturdays of October-June you may bring them to the church to be blessed. Also, each First Friday and Saturday from October to June we will offer prayers for the consecration of the Parish Family and each individual family.

Reminder:

We do not collect items for the needy or rummage sales. If items are left outside or in the church, they are thrown into the trash. With bed bugs and such and not having a place to store such items, we can not collect the items. Thank you.

Maintenance and Repairs:

Two out of the four Air conditioning Units are down in the church. This will be addressed ASAP. The Church can't cool properly with only two units running. And so until all is up and running, it will be warm.
