Marriages: Reserve and register date & time as soon as possible, at least six months in advance of the wedding. Pre-Cana and other instructional sessions are required for all couples.

Ministry to the Sick: Please call the Rectory.

NOTE: Sponsor letters: Church law requires sponsors to be active, registered Catholics and live according to Church teachings.

Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA): Are you interested in becoming a Catholic? Please call the Rectory.

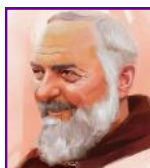

From the desk of Fr. Saffron:

I feel like I just turned the calendar to August, and here I am writing about a feast which falls right in the middle of the month, the Assumption of Mary, which means summer will be over in about six weeks.

We will celebrate the Assumption with three days of spiritual exercises. On the 13th at 6 pm, I will offer a blessing of fresh water for use in the church and for you to use at home; please bring a bottle.

I will also bless oil and salt. Please bring your own. These items are used for devotional and practical purposes. Both serve as safeguards against evil. The salt as it preserves food and adds flavor help in the same way with our spiritual lives. The oil helps to remind us of God's graces and goodness.

Breads will be blessed, too. Usually, we think of bread being blessed at Easter since bread symbolizes resurrection. Bread also is a symbol of life and being sustained by God. Here, I'd like to pause and reflect on the Assumption. This feast is sometimes called the "Summer Pascha"! This summer, Passover of the Mother of God is such a special celebration of Mary's passing from the earthly life to the Eternal Life, and this is why bread will be blessed.

At 6:30 pm, a Low Mass will be offered, followed by the Lamentations of Mary. These are beautiful, chanted prayers telling us of the accounts of Mary's Dormition and Assumption. There will be a procession too.

On the 14th and 15th Flowers and Herbs will be blessed after all Assumption Masses. Please bring flowers and herbs for blessing.

On the 15th, after the 7 pm Mass a procession will take place, and you are all invited to bring an image of Mary to carry
