Life Line

Assisted suicide is a deadly mix with our profit-driven health care system.

• Some patients in Oregon have received word from the Oregon Health Plan that it will pay for assisted suicide but will not pay for treatment that may sustain their lives.



• Patients enrolled in private health plans are meeting with similar discrimination and pressure to commit suicide. One patient in California was told by her insurance

company that it would not pay for her life-extending treatment but that she "would only

have to pay \$1.20" for drugs to commit suicide.
