**Baptisms:** Please call the rectory to arrange the celebration of Baptism. (Baptisms ordinarily should not take place during Lent except in case of emergency. )

**Marriages:** Reserve and register date & time as soon as possible, at least six months in advance of the wedding. Pre-Cana and other instructional sessions are required for all couples.

**Ministry to the Sick:** Please call the Rectory.

**NOTE: Sponsor letters:** Church law requires sponsors to be active, registered Catholics and live according to Church teachings.

**Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA):** Are you interested in becoming a Catholic? Please call the Rectory.
