**Marriages:** Reserve and register date & time as soon as possible, at least six months in advance of the wedding. Pre-Cana and other instructional sessions are required for all couples.

**Ministry to the Sick:** Please call the Rectory.

**NOTE: Sponsor letters:** Church law requires sponsors to be active, registered Catholics and live according to Church teachings.

**Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA):** Are you interested in becoming a Catholic? Please call the Rectory.

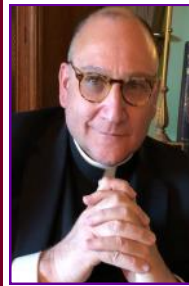

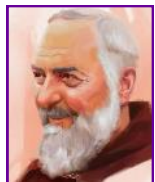

## Life Line



“Each year on September 11, the families of the victims gather at the site of the Twin Towers for a memorial service where the names of the 2,983 victims are read aloud. Alongside 10 of the names, the words, “and her unborn child” are read. These names, which are inscribed on the 9/11 memorial along with 2,972 others, as well as Monica Rodriguez Smith and her unborn child who were killed in the 1993 terrorist bombing at the World Trade Center, remind Americans of the impact of every life.

“And her unborn child” is not a political statement or a pro-life campaign. It is simply the statement of a fact. On September 11, 2001, in an attack on the World Trade Center, terrorists took the lives of nearly 3,000 Americans — 10 of them were unborn children.
